REPORTS UPDATE

RCRAInfo

Development Goals:

- Enhancing, simplifying and streamlining report criteria
- Moving from Oracle Reports to Jasper
 - All reports are being converted and analyzed as part of this process
- Getting more (and better) data out of RCRAInfo
 - Come to the 2019 National Users Conference with ideas to share!

Recently Released Reports:

- e-Manifest Inspectors Report
 - Provides a list of manifests for a site with each report row representing a manifest line number on a manifest.
- Migration of CM&E Reports from V5 to V6 (including Region 6's Reports)
 - Violations not returned to compliance
 - Evaluations by Type

- There are a lot of reports in V5 and V6
 - Explore them in the applications, or reach out to your RCRAInfo State and Regional contacts
- The Group of IDs function in V5 will allow you to generate a set of IDs using custom criteria. You can then run reports in V5 and V6 on those IDs.
- Report History "rerun" – You can go into Report History any time and re-run a prior report
- V6 Reports are stored in your Report History queue for future reference.
- Click the "?" icon for even more information about reports, including SQL logic

- Migration of more reports to V6
 - As we move each module to V6, the corresponding reports will be analyzed for usage and moved
- New reporting tools
 - What features in a reporting tool are most important to you?
- What else?
 - Are the current reports suiting your business needs? If so, why, and, if not, why not?
 - What new features do you want to see?
 - What can be improved?
