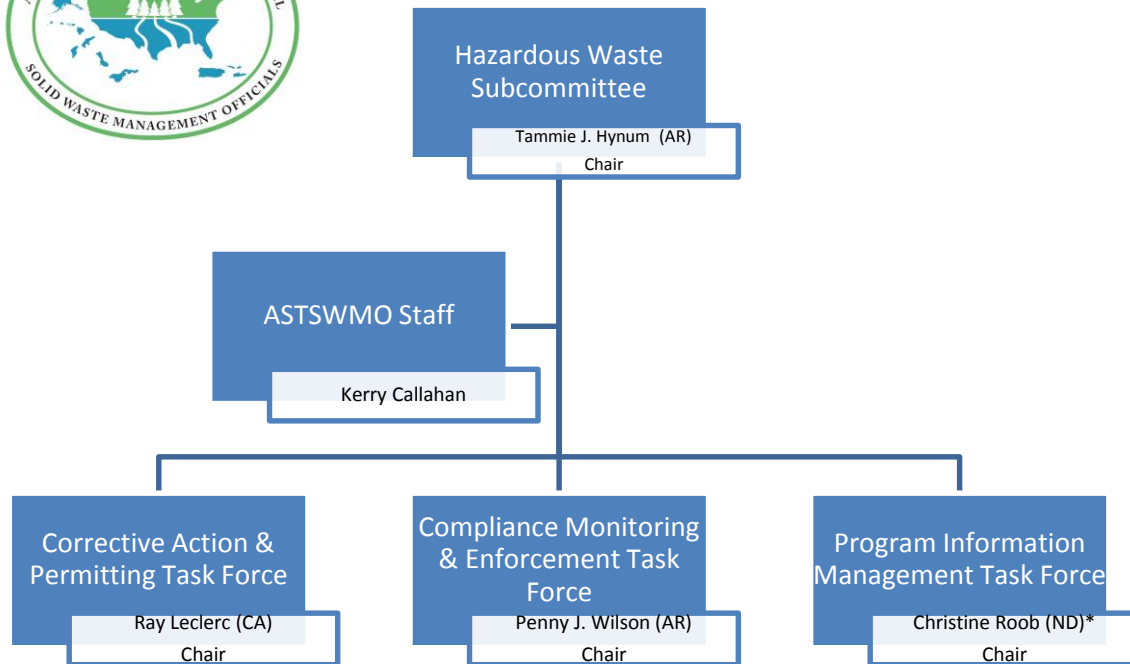




ASTSWMO HAZARDOUS WASTE SUBCOMMITTEE MEMBERS IN ACTION FACT SHEET
